2. VENUE Abbotside Farm, Cromhall, Glos, GL12 8AW. O/S Map 162 Ref 683905
3. START TIME 11:00 am. Machines must be scrutineered and in closed control 30 minutes before start time. Scrutineering starts at 9.30 am.
4. ENTRIES Entries are available on-line through the ACU website or on the event Entry Form. Entries close on Monday 17th July 2017 and will be limited to the first 120 received. **All drivers must be a member of an ACU Club.**
5. FEES Solo £50.00. Club Membership £3.00. Day Licence (If Required) £15.00. Day licences must be purchased before the event, preferably from ACU online entry system.
6. CLASSES A Enduro – Expert; to display green number plate with white number.
 B Enduro – Veteran Expert (Over 40); as Expert number plate with blue underline.
 C Enduro – Clubman; yellow number plate with black number.
 D Enduro – Veteran Clubman (Over 40); blue number plate with white number.
 E Enduro – Sportsman; black number plate with white number.
 F Trail and Trial; as Sportsman number plate with blue underline.
 Each class will be run subject to a minimum of 6 entries in class. A lesser number will compete in the next highest class. Please state class on entry form. Competitors are required to provide their own number plates according to ACU ESR11, which must conform to the standard give for each class above. NOTE----Please remember your coloured plate and numbers.
7. STARTING ORDER Drivers will be started in groups of similar classified entries. The time differential between the start time of the classes and the starting order is at the organisers' discretion, and this time is taken into account when results are produced. Machines MUST be pushed to start line with DEAD engines and started at the signalled start time.
8. ROUTE Approximately 3 miles per lap. Course consists of tracks and field paths. The course will be marked with tape and arrows. **Where arrows are in pairs the riders must pass between them. Where course is taped to form a corner or chicane the riders must pass within the tapes. Failure to do so or any course cutting will mean disqualification.**
9. GENERAL The route is used is all on private land and drivers and support crews are asked to ensure that there is no damaged caused. Refuelling is to be carried out only where designated by the club and competitors are to provide their own Environmental Mats (see ESR 34). Competitors are also to provide their own 2kg dry powder fire extinguisher (see ESR 49). Competitors will be notified of number and final instructions. This number must be displayed, as per class (see ESR), on front and rear of machines, and the onus is on the competitor to ensure that their number is recorded by the lap scorers. Timing for this event will be by transponder. Competitors who do not have a transponder will be loaned one for the duration of the event.
10. TYPE OF EVENT An enduro style course in which riders will start at intervals in classes and ride until the advised finishing time when the number of laps completed will decide the event (approx 2½ hours duration) to qualify as a finisher the competitor must pass the finishing flag with engine running.
11. NOISE Any competitor whose machine becomes noisy during the event will be stopped until repairs are carried out to the satisfaction of the officials.
